AWARDS

A qualifying ribbon will be awarded to each team who earns a score of 170 or higher. Placement ribbons will be awarded as follows:

First Place.....Blue
Second Place.....Red
Third Place.....Yellow
Fourth Place.....White

A High in Trial award will be given for each trial. Special awards will be given for High Scoring MMBC Member, High Scoring Mixed Breed, and High Scoring Junior Handler.

New Title rosettes will be given for any new titles earned at our CDSP trials.

Move-ups

Move-ups from one trial to the next will be accepted. A move-up form must be submitted to the trial secretary at least 20 minutes prior to the start of the class.

Reminder – To earn a title you must have three qualifying scores under two different judges.

Notice to Exhibitors

Competitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of CDSP Competition Obedience rules and regulations including but not limited to the following rules regarding entry:

- ◆ This trial is open to all dogs being at least six months of age, including purebred and non-purebred, except bitches in season or dogs with disabilities, injuries or illnesses which may cause the dog pain or great discomfort, or dogs exhibiting signs of aggression that threaten the safety of other dogs or humans.
- ◆ All dogs must be registered with CDSP obedience to compete.
- ◆ Dogs must be shown by the owner or a member of the owner's immediate family: mother, father, spouse, life partner, sibling, child, grandparent, or grandchild.
- ◆ Safety shall always be of foremost consideration in actions and conduct by handlers at all times. Handlers, through entry at this event, accept full responsibility for themselves and the actions of their dogs.
- ◆ The organizing committee may refuse any entry for any reason.

In addition,

- ◆ THERE SHALL BE NO REFUND in the event a dog and/or handler are dismissed from competition, regardless of reason for such dismissal. There will be no refunds if the trial has to be cancelled for any reason.
- ◆ Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry. There will be a \$35.00 service charge for returned checks. Payment of entry fees and service charges shall be made in cash or money order within 30 days of postmark of notice of returned check where notification is received after event date. Any fees not received within 30 days of notice will result in cancellation of event results for all classes for the registration number(s) of delinquent entry/entries. No reinstatement of results is possible, and all awards must be returned within 10 days of notification, or the dog's registration may be suspended pending restitution. Any unpaid fees or shortfalls must be paid prior to the start of the event or entry is canceled without recourse by owner/handler.
- ◆ No entry fees will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, Act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strike or any other cause beyond the control of the organizers.
- ◆ Collars may be flat, buckle type collars or limited slip martingale type collars. **No choke collars, head collars, prong collars, electronic collars.** Body harnesses may be allowed if the dog is required to wear one due to medical reasons. In this case, the handler must furnish a veterinarian's note stating this. Collars must be properly fitted and while they may have tags on them, the tags must not interfere with a dog's movement. Dogs may not have decorative items around their neck nor on their collars.
- ◆ All competitors through entry at this event waive any and all rights relative to video broadcast of this event. Competitors shall have the right to videotape portions of this event for their personal use only. No portion of this event may be videotaped for commercial or other purposes.
- ◆ Owners with disabilities are encouraged to compete. Any necessary modifications to the exercises must be provided by the handler to the judge and approved by the judge.
- ◆ This event will be held indoors on rubber mat flooring.
- ◆ Dogs must be on leash while on show grounds.
- ◆ Day kenneling only is permitted. Crates may be left overnight at your own risk.
- ◆ Please pick up after your dog and yourself.

A, B, and C Classes

Starter Novice A: Shall be for dogs who have not earned any other obedience title in any registry and does not have a qualifying score (Q) in Novice in any obedience registry.

Starter Novice B: Shall be for dogs who have earned a Beginner Novice (BN) obedience title or equivalent in any registry and does not have a qualifying score (Q) in Novice in any obedience registry.

Starter Novice C: Shall be for dogs who have earned a CDSP Starter Novice title (SN-C) in either the A or B class and does not have a qualifying score (Q) in Novice in any obedience registry.

Novice A: Shall be for dogs who have not earned any other obedience title in any registry.

Novice B: Shall be for dogs who have earned an obedience title in any registry.

Novice C: Shall be for dogs who have earned a CDSP Novice title (CD-) in either the A or B class.

Open A: Shall be for dogs who have earned the CDSP Novice obedience title (CD-C).

Open B: Shall be for dogs who have earned the CDSP Novice obedience title (CD-C) and/or any other Open obedience titles in any registry.

Open C: Shall be for dogs who have earned a CDSP Open title (CDX-C) in either the A or B class.

Utility A: Shall be for dogs who have earned the CDSP Open obedience title (CDX-C).

Utility B: Shall be for dogs who have earned the CDSP Utility obedience title (UD-C) and who wish to earn a CDSP Utility Dog Excellent title (UDX-C) and a CDSP Obedience Trial Championship title (OTCH-C).

Utility C: Shall be for dogs who have earned the CDSP Utility obedience title (UD-C) and who wish to earn the CDSP Utility Championship obedience title (UD-CCH).

Versatility A: Shall be for dogs who have earned the CDSP Novice Championship obedience title (CD-CCH).

Versatility B: Shall be for dogs who have earned the CDSP Novice Championship obedience title (CD-CCH) and any other Open or Utility qualifying leg or obedience title in any registry.

Versatility C: Shall be for dogs who have earned a CDSP Versatility title (VT-C) in either the A or B class.

Please submit your entry based on your dog's current status. If you earn a title between submitting your entry and the trial date, please notify the Trial Secretary immediately so that you can be moved to the appropriate class.

General Information

Food and beverages will be available, and is free for all exhibitors, workers, and guests. Please feel free to bring something to share.

Facility, Check-In

Doors open at 8:00 am. Check in at any time prior to Trial.

Day of Show entries must be submitted no later than ½ hour prior to the start of the class being entered.

Dogs may be crated in the facility, and some chairs are available to competitors. Most crating space is on mats. Please bring something to place under your crate and chair to protect the mats.

Judging will begin at 9:00 am.

Running Order

All trials will start with Novice, followed by Starter Novice, then Open, then Versatility, then Utility. Trial #2 will follow the completion of Trial #1, and after the judge has had the opportunity to take a break.

To enter our trials, you must have a CDSP registration number for your dog. It takes 2 to 6 weeks to receive your number. Entries without a number cannot be accepted.

There will be no refunds for absent entries. Refunds will be made for withdrawn entries provided request is made prior to closing date. Refunds, minus administration fees, will be made for bitches in season or injured dogs if request is made prior to check-in and is accompanied by a note from the exhibitor's veterinarian.

GENERAL AGREEMENT

I (we) agree that MMBC (the hosting club) has the right to refuse this entry for any cause which the organizing committee alone shall deem to be sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry, of the holding of the event, and of the opportunity to have the dog participate and/or to be judged, I (we) agree to hold the organizing committee, the hosting club, Companion Dog Sports Program, including their members, officers, directors, agents and employees, sponsors of the event, and owners of the premises upon which the event is held and their employees, harmless from any claim for loss or injury that may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or upon the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim. I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss of this dog by disappearance, theft, death or otherwise, and from any claim for damage or injury to the dog, whether such loss, disappearance, appearance, theft, damage, or injury be caused or alleged to be caused by the negligence of the parties aforementioned, or by the negligence of any other person, or any other cause or causes. I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death resulting at any time therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, howsoever such injuries, death, or damage to property may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may have been alleged to have been caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees or agents or any other persons.

I (we) further acknowledge that I (we) have read, understand, and will abide by the Official Rules and Regulations of Companion Dog Sports Program and the provisions for entry as set forth in the Trial Schedule of which this entry form is a part. I (we) acknowledge and represent that the information supplied by me (us) herein is correct to the best of my (our) knowledge; if any portion of this information is found to be invalid or insufficient to establish the validity of my (our) entry, such finding shall render my (our) entry invalid in its entirety, for which there shall be no refund of fees paid. Further, I (we) represent that I am (we are) the owner(s) of the dog listed hereon, or that I (we) am (are) a family member of the dog's owner as stated and allowed in the CDSP rules, and that I (we) shall hold the hosting club and CDSP, including their officers, directors, employees and agents and their sponsors, harmless from any liability or claim made by dog's owner.

Further, I (we) hereby grant to Companion Dog Sports Program their representatives, agents, and assigns, all rights and permissions to use or appropriate my and the dog's name, biography, likeness, photograph, voice, performing persona, or other indicia or identity for broadcast, telecast, cablecast, transmission, or distribution in any format or media now known or hereafter to become known. I (we) hereby release Companion Dog Sports Program, the hosting club, their representatives, agents, and assigns from any claim or cause of action for invasion of the rights of privacy, right of personality, or any similar right.
