Check In/Walkthru

(Times subject to change based on entries)

Friday: Setup after 3:00. Measuring after 3:30. Walkthru around 3:45. First dog on the line at 4:00.
Saturday/Sunday: Setup after 7:00. Measuring after 7:30. Walkthru around 7:45. First dog on the line at 8:00.

Measuring

All proficient dogs jumping 16" or less without a permanent height card need to be measured. Proficient dogs jumping 20" and skilled dogs do not need to be measured.

Closing Date/Move Ups

Closing Date and Move-ups: Closing date for entries and move-ups is August 27, 2018.
There will be no day to day move-ups at this trial.

Equipment

Equipment to be used may include jumps (wing and/or wingless), a-frame, dog walk, open tunnels, weave poles, hoops, and barrels. All contacts are rubber surfaced.

Final confirmations will be e-mailed out in the week prior to the trial. Please read your confirmations carefully and notify the trial secretary (dittmk@gmail.com) or by phone (612-245-5430) if there are any corrections that need to be made. If changes need to be made the day of the trial there will be a \$5 charge per class.

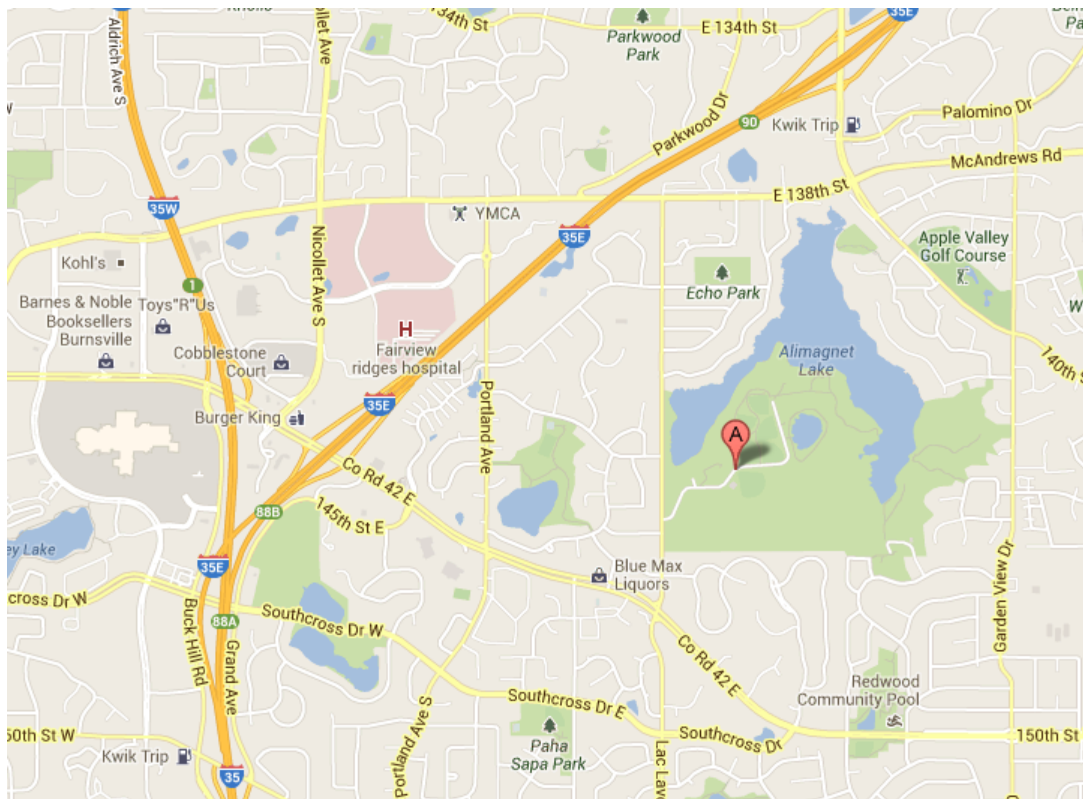
Directions

From the north/west/east:

35E or 35 W South to County Rd 42 (Egan Dr). Left (East) on County Rd 42. Left (North) on Country Rd 11 to Alimagnet Pkwy on the right (West). Continue to the back of the park. The trial site is on the soccer fields at the end of the park road.

From the south:

35 North to 35E to County Rd 42 (Egan Dr). Right (East) on County Rd 42. Left (North) on Country Rd 11 to Alimagnet Pkwy on the right (West). Continue to the back of the park. The trial site is on the soccer fields at the end of the park road.



NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

Below is a brief summary of NADAC rules. Please refer to www.nadac.com for a full explanation of all NADAC rules and up to date information.

- Please note that NADAC trials should provide a safe and fun environment for both exhibitors and their dogs.
- Aggressive dogs will not be tolerated and will be excused from the trial.
- The show committee has the right to refuse any entry. Anyone not currently in good standing with NADAC will not be allowed to enter this trial.
- Exhibitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of NADAC rules and regulations, and agree to abide by all rules in effect at the time of this trial.
- No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reasons of riots, civil disturbances, fire, acts of God, public emergency, an act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- There shall be no refunds for entries withdrawn after the closing date, or in the event that the dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a judge or the club, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee.
- Refunds minus administration fees will be made if a Veterinarian's certificate of proof of injury or illness of the dog or a bitch in heat is submitted to the Trial Secretary PRIOR TO CHECK IN ON THE FIRST DAY THE DOG IS ENTERED.
- Checks not honored by the bank do not constitute a valid entry fee. There be a \$25.00 service charge for bank returned checks.
- **Dog must be registered and have a valid registration number before entries will be accepted.

- All healthy, trained dogs over eighteen (18) months of age are eligible to compete in NADAC agility trials. Bitches in heat, lame or blind dogs are ineligible for entry, as is any dog with a deformity which may cause a judge to not be able to reasonably assess the dog's ability to function and perform agility obstacles safely, and in a manner that is in the best interest, health and welfare of the dog.
- Any dog that demonstrates aggression towards any person or any dog whether inside the ring or outside the ring, may be excused from the agility trial. Any dog which the judge feels is not in enough control to perform all obstacles in a safe manner may be excused from the agility trial.
- This event will be held outdoors on grass. Bring water and shade for yourself and your dog.
- All exhibitors are responsible for the behavior of their dog(s) and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dog(s) and/or children engage in disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such a case no refund of entries will be made.
- The Club, its agents or assigns will not be responsible for the loss of damage to any dog exhibited, or for the possessions of any exhibitor whether the result was by accident or any other cause. It is distinctly understood that every dog at this event is in the care and custody and control of his owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the show premises.
- Dogs must be on leash anywhere on the show grounds property, or in crates when not competing in the ring. NO dogs may be tied to fences, cars, trees or other obstacles at any time.
- Please pick up after your dogs. Anyone not picking up after dogs or pottyng dogs in "dog free" areas will be asked to leave without refund.
- No leads, collars, food, toys, balls, clickers or other aids or devices shall be permitted on the course at any time. No food, toys, balls or other training devices may be used within ten (10) feet of the entrance to the ring.
- Placements ribbons will be awarded to at least fourth place in each jump height for each class, in each category, except Chances which is a pass/fail class. A purple qualifying ribbon shall be given for each qualifying round in each class.

Dogs which require measuring:
Dogs in the Proficient Category, Novice, Open or Elite jumping 4", 8", 12" or 16"
Dogs which do not need to be measured:
Dogs jumping 16" in the Veteran or Junior Handler Division, dogs jumping 20", dogs in the Skilled Category, dogs with a permanent height card, and dogs listed on the Height Exemption List

- **NON-JUMPING CLASSES – VETERAN OR DISABLED HANDLER**

Handlers who are 60 years or older, or who have a disability that restricts mobility, may choose to enter the non-jumping classes as a Veteran Handler and receive 10% more standard course time. This option is for Veteran/Disabled handlers in the non-jumping classes only.

The Veteran/Disabled Handler division is designed for handlers who, due to age or impairment, are mobility limited and need extra time to guide their canine partners through an agility course.

When entering as a Veteran/Disabled Handler, you must enter all dogs in all classes for the entire trial in this Division and must jump 4” lower than your Standard Division jump height requires. In the non-jumping classes, dogs will be scored and placed with their Standard Division jump height.

IMPORTANT. Please check your dog's NADAC registration number on your trial confirmation as soon as you receive it; also, please check the copy of the results posted at the trial. You should report any errors to the Trial Secretary immediately.

NADAC records trial results as they are submitted by the host clubs/groups. The individual trial results submitted by the club are uploaded to the www.NADACForum.com within two weeks after the NADAC office receives them from the club. Please accept the responsibility to review those results, and check that your registration number and qualifying points, as reported by the club, are correct. You can join the Forum by going to www.NADACForum.com and submitting your request. If you find an error in the reporting of your dog's qualifying points or registration number, please contact the host club. The host club is responsible for correcting any errors and informing NADAC.

Levels. Points earned at a higher level of a class, prior to the completion of the lower level title, will not be recorded by NADAC for future use. If a dog earns points in a level of a class that they are not eligible to title in, those points will not be added to the dog's records.

What is the Intro level of NADAC Agility?

The Intro level will be a shorter course than Novice. The only Intro level class with weaves will be Intro Weavers and it will have one set of 6 poles. No other classes will have weaves in them. The Intro level will have no tunnel/contact discriminations. The Intro level is a full titling level with the basic titles at 30 points, Outstanding Performance at 60 points and Superior Performance at 100 points for Chances, Jumpers, Tunnelers, Weavers, Hoopers, and Touch N Go. For Regular the basic title is at 30 points, Outstanding Performance is at 100 points and Superior Performance is at 200 points. You may move to Novice level without finishing Intro level titles.

AGREEMENT

1. As used here 'NADAC' means North American Dog Agility Council, LLC., its members, officers, directors, employees, show chairs, show committees and agents. As used here 'MMBC' means Minnesota Mixed Breed Club its members, officers, directors, employees, show chairs, show committees and agents.
2. Exhibitor/owner, agree to abide by the rules and regulations of NADAC, and any other rules and regulations appearing in the premium for this event.
3. Exhibitor/owner certifies that the entered dog is not a hazard to persons, dogs, or property and that the entered dog's rabies vaccination is current in accordance with the requirement of the state in which the dog resides.
4. Exhibitor/owner acknowledge all hazards presented by the event and the event premises, including, but not limited to, the condition of the floors, stairways, halls, lighting, security measures or lack of, electrical appliances, fitting, show rings, parking areas and the presence of unfamiliar animals and people; exhibitor and owner assume the risk of any harm arising from these.
5. Exhibitor/owner release NADAC (including NADAC officers, directors, employees, and members), the Minnesota Mixed Breed Club (including its officers, directors, and members, and event organizing committee), and the City of Burnsville (including its officers, agents, and employees) and will defend them and hold them harmless from all present and future loss, injury, damage, claims, demands and liabilities involving the entered dog, the event or event premises.
